) iscipline plan

See the letter E for our expectations. If your child chooses not to meet these expectations the following consequences will automatically take place. I use a sign that looks like a stop light. Green- doing great, 1st- warning, 2nd- move to yellow, 3rd- move to red. Depending on the severity of the issue, when a student pulls a red card, this may result in a call, note, or e-mail home, or an office referral.

xpectations

We have three classroom expectations to follow. After the first week, ask your child if they know them! Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible!
